LOVE IS NOT BOASTFUL OR PROUD

The points from last week's message were:

- Pride and love cannot co-exist
- Boastfulness and pride are two sides of the same coin.
- The antidote to boasting and pride is to honour God in prayer and listen to what He wants us to do.
