LET'S TALK

1. What impacted you the most from this week's message?

4. Share one way you've been blessed by your small group.
5. Tim Keller says, “People are messy; therefore, relationships will be messy. Expect messiness.” As a small group, do you expect messiness or are you surprised (and disappointed) when it happens? Has your group discussed how it will respond when things get “messy”?
6. Pastor Steve talks about the “vow of stability” and the importance of being committed to your community. What is one way you can deepen your commitment to your small group and to your fellow group members?
