THE POINTS FROM THIS MESSAGE WERE:

- Replace worry with worship.
- Live in the sure hope of a renewed world.

LET'S TALK

1. What impacted you the most from this week's message?
2. Read Luke 1:26-38. If you were in Mary's shoes, what do you think your response would have been to the angel's message?
3. Do you find that you worry more now than you did a year ago? Why or why not?
4. The message mentions three different acts of worship: reading scripture, listening to worship music and joining Sunday morning services. Which of these helps you most to deal with worry?
5. Read Luke 1: 46-55. Thinking about the situation Mary finds herself in, what does her song say about who she is?
6. Pastor Steve says, "If living in the hope of a world renewed buffers us against despair when it seems like the world is falling apart, then at the same time, it compels us to spend ourselves in the loving service of the poor, hungry, sick, hurting, oppressed, and vulnerable of this world, whether locally, or globally."
