LET'S TALK

1. What impacted you the most from this week's message?
2. Describe a time you felt like you were doing what you were meant to do.
3. Read Ephesians 2:10.
 - a. What part of this verse resonates with you the most?
 - b. God's "handiwork" can refer to a story written by a storyteller. What's a part of your life story that reveals something about God's character?
 - c. Being created "in Christ Jesus" means we understand our story only as it fits into God's story. Do you think people tend to do this or do they tend to fit God into their own story? What difference do you think it makes in how people live their lives?
 - d. Frederick Buechner says, "The place where God calls you is where your deep gladness meets the world's deep hunger." What issue or injustice do you feel strongly about?
4. Instead of asking ourselves What Would Jesus Do, Dallas Willard suggests that it's more helpful to ask How Would Jesus Live if he were you. As you think about the week ahead, what is one thing Jesus would do if he were you?
