LET'S TALK

1. What impacted you the most from this week's message?
2. Have you ever had an "Us and Them" mentality before? Do you ever look at people who have different attitudes, beliefs and lifestyles and put them into another category?
3. Read Genesis 12:1-3.
 - What reason does God give for blessing his people?
 - From what you know of the Israelites, how did they live out that purpose?
 - In what ways are we tempted to keep the blessing for ourselves rather than bless others with what we've been blessed with?
4. Pastor Kevin says, "The tension is that some of us would rather do the good that makes the world better, but leave the Jesus part out because we don't want to offend anybody. And some of us only want to talk about Jesus but not do anything to make the world better."
Do you relate to any of these tensions?
5. In Jesus, we see how much God is for us (John 3:16). Pastor Kevin says, "He shows us how much he is for us. So much that he was willing to put others first, suffer and even lay down his life. God calls us to have that same type of sacrificial love. To make friends with enemies, to seek the well-being of everyone around us."
How does Jesus' sacrificial love for you challenge you in the way you love others?
