YOU ARE YOUR BOUNDARIES

THE POINTS FROM THIS WEEK'S MESSAGE WERE:

- Boundaries that are REMOVED in Christ
- Boundaries that are REINFORCED in Christ

LET'S TALK

1. What impacted you the most from this week's message?
2. Pastor Steve says that boundaries help distinguish who you are and who you are not. Have you ever experienced a situation where boundaries were violated?
3. Being "in Christ" means you have left your old life behind and are identified with Jesus above all else. In what ways do you think this identity marker defines us and governs all our other boundaries?
4. One of the boundaries that are broken in Christ is the boundary that excludes people on the basis of race, ethnicity, culture, class and gender. Have you ever been excluded because of any of these factors? What does it mean to you that in Christ, God has removed these boundaries that separated people from each other?
5. Pastor Steve suggests these helpful questions that can help us identify and set boundaries in the way we live.
 - a. Do you need to set firmer and clearer boundaries around what you watch on TV or online?
 - b. Do you need to set firmer boundaries around the material you read?
 - c. Do you need to set firmer boundaries around how you spend your time?
 - d. Do you need to set firmer boundaries around the way you spend your money?
 - e. Do you need to set firmer boundaries around who you hang out with?
 - f. Do you need to set firmer boundaries around your speech – around the words you say?
 - g. Do you need to join the psalmist in praying: Set a guard over my mouth, Lord; keep watch over the door of my lips.

Which of these boundaries do you need most right now?

6. What is one boundary you sense God wants you to put in place this week? What is your first step towards doing that?
