THE POINTS FROM THIS WEEK'S MESSAGE WERE:

- The beauty of God's presence.
 - Jesus is the ultimate reflection of God's glory and beauty.
- The beauty of a renewed creation.

LET'S TALK

1. What impacted you the most from this week's message?
2. Can you remember a time when you were moved by beauty – whether in nature or art or music or literature or a great recipe or a newborn baby or an act of kindness or anything else? How did it make you feel?
3. Read Psalm 19:1-6. What does the beauty of nature teach us about the creator?
4. Pastor Steve says that those who follow Jesus are God's tabernacle and temple. How can an understanding of this change the way we see ourselves and others?.
5. In the message Pastor Steve quotes C.S Lewis who says, "We do not want merely to see beauty... We want something else which can hardly be put into words – to be united with the beauty we see, to pass into it, to receive it into ourselves, to bathe in it, to become part of it." Do you relate to this desire to be immersed in beauty?
6. What is one thing you can do this week to reflect God's beauty into the world?
