GLOBAL JUSTICE

THE POINTS FROM THIS WEEK'S MESSAGE WERE:

- Where is God nudging you?
- What's in your hands?
- Don't be a hero and don't go alone.

LET'S TALK

1. What impacted you the most from this week's message?
2. Read Mark 12:30-31. Bethany says that justice is what love looks like when it is lived out in public. It's the intersection of the two greatest commands. Have you ever thought of justice that way? What do you like about this definition? How does it inspire you to do justice?
3. *Hesed* or loving kindness is an essential part of God's character. Read the following verses: Exodus 34:5-7, Lamentations 3:22-23. How have you personally experienced God's loving kindness? What about his loving kindness stands out for you the most?
4. The Old Testament is full of grace-filled laws of compassion (Lev 19:9-10). We see this in the New Testament too as Jesus commands people to love their neighbour as themselves. What do you think most people find challenging about loving others? How might that push us away from truly following Jesus? How might that actually draw us to follow Jesus more deeply?
5. Justice is about relationships. Living in right relationship with God, with others and with the world. In Jesus, God is restoring all these relationships. He is the one who will ultimately "rebuild all that is broken, restore all that is lost and put right all that is wrong in the world." How does it encourage you to know that God will restore all things? How does this challenge you to join him in this mission and be a "Justice Bringer" wherever you are?
6. We've been saying, "Don't be a hero and don't go alone!" What are some ways your group can work together for justice. (Eg. sponsor a child, do an [outreach](#) together, pursue an issue you feel passionate about, etc.)
