## **LET'S TALK**

- 1. What impacted you the most from this week's message?
- 2. Are you looking forward to Christmas this year? Dreading it? A bit of both? What has shaped your feelings about the Christmas season?
- 3. Read Gen 3:15, 22:18, 2 Sam 7:16, Micah 5:2 and Jer 33:15-16. What does reading these passages bring to your understanding of the meaning of Christmas?
- 4. Read Isa 53:2-5. How does thinking about the suffering of Jesus affect your view of Christmas?
- 5. In his message Dave says, "So the love of God is the love of the sovereign lord of all history, and it is a sacrificial love, sending his own son to save the whole world, but I have to admit that sometimes I wonder: would a God like that ever pay attention to someone like me?" Do you ever question whether you are worthy of God's attention? Why do you think that is?
- 6. Looking at the main points from the message: God's love is Sovereign, God's love is Sacrificial and God's love is Personal, which of these to you find easiest to believe? Which one do you find hardest?
- 7. What is one thing you can do this week to show the love of God to someone else?
