How to be a witness in our marriage

- Care: We stand by others by entering into their pain.
- Brotherly Love: We look out for each other like family.

- 1. What impacted you the most from this week's message?

- 3. Read 1 Peter 2:12.

- 4. Read 1 Peter 3:1-7. How do we generally think about submission? How is the call for Christians to submit different?
- Read 1 Peter 3:8-12.

- 6. Pastor Jeremy says that showing care means to stand by others and enter into their pain. What makes it hard for us to do that? When was a time someone did that for you? What did that mean to you?
- 7. Is there someone in your life who could use a friend? How can you walk with this person and demonstrate God's love?
