## **DISCUSS**

- 1. Share about a time you were on the "outside" of community and someone welcomed you in. What did that experience feel like?
- **2.** Do you agree with the observation that once people have formed close relationships, they tend to turn inward and form cliques? If so, why do you think this happens?
- **3.** Share about a time you served others (eg volunteering, missions trip, helping some out, etc.). How did that experience impact you?
- **4.** Read Mark 10:45. Do you think our culture has an attitude of wanting to be served or to serve? What are some ways you see that?

**5.** In John 13, Jesus tells his disciples to follow his example and serve others. Why do you think serving is so important to reaching others for Jesus?

### **PRAYER**

Divide into groups of two or three. Share a prayer request for yourself. Pray for each other.

## **HOUSEKEEPING**

**Potluck:** Next week is your group's last session. Celebrate with a potluck dinner. Coordinate what people will bring.

**Gift:** Next week, you will spend time giving and receiving small gifts to one another. Thoughtfully *find* one tangible item that symbolizes your experience in this Starter Group (eg something you learned, a memory that sticks out, friendships you've formed, etc.).
