HEROES OF FAITH: MOSES

LET'S TALK

1. What impacted you the most from this week's message?
2. In his plan to free the Israelites from oppression, God displays his unstoppable power through a series of plagues. What are some ways you've experienced God's power in your life?
3. Read Exodus 15:1-2. Pastor Steve says, Don't just ask God to GIVE you strength. Ask God to BE your strength. What do you think is the difference?
4. Read Exodus 15:3-7. God doesn't just impart you with strength to fight your battles, he himself will fight the battle for you. How does this truth encourage you?
5. Read Exodus 15:9. In ancient times, to have a chariot army was to be unstoppable. People looked to chariots to provide strength and security. What "chariots" do you think people look to today? What are some "chariots" in your life?
6. Read Exodus 15:9-12. In this passage, Moses renews his faith by looking back at what God has done for his people. How has God delivered you in the past? How might this give you perspective for the challenges you currently face?

Pastor Steve says,

When facing a crisis: Look forward to a world forever set right. The Red Sea victory points ahead to a greater victory — a greater salvation — that Jesus the Lamb purchased for us through his death and resurrection. In that salvation is the hope that the whole creation will ultimately be set right.

7. We often think that this world is all there is. Yet the Bible points towards an ultimate Promised Land where all of creation will be renewed and restored. What difference does it make to live in light of this ultimate hope?

In the coming week, make this your breath prayer: God, BE my strength! Don't let your challenges overwhelm you but instead rest in the knowledge that the battle belongs to the Lord and he himself is fighting for you.
