How did Jesus have a servant heart?

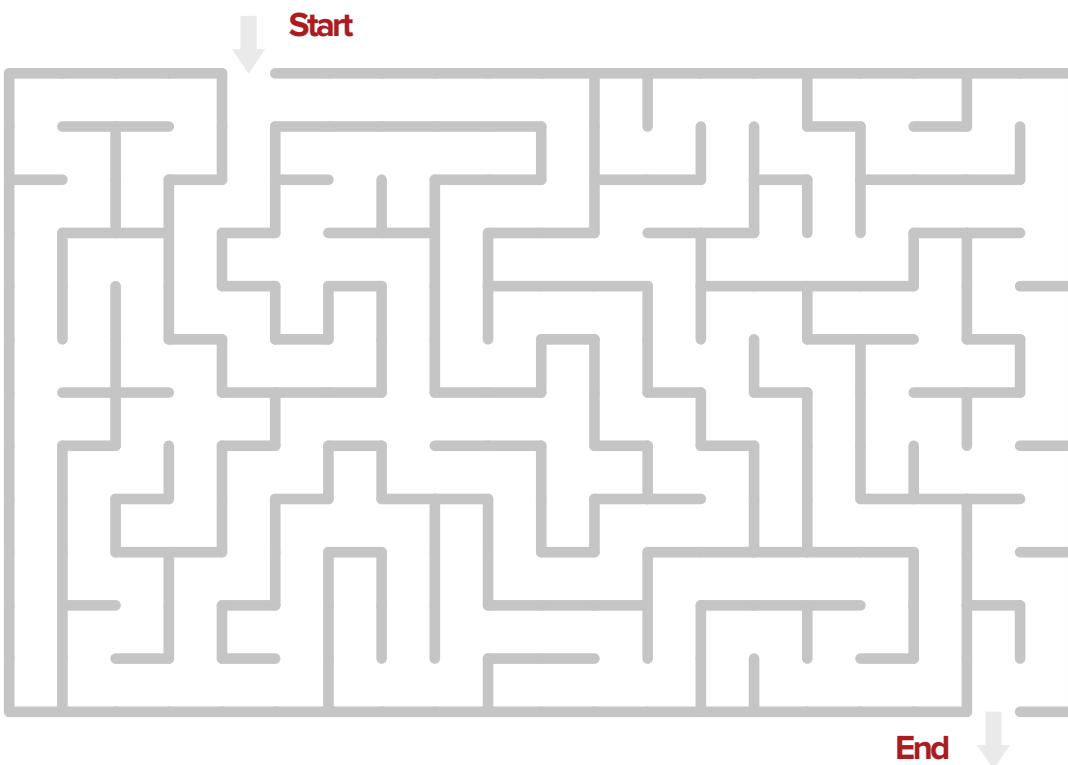
How can you have a servant heart and love those who are hard to love?

THURSDAY

Now it is Passover, but before Jesus sits down to eat with his friends He gets down on His knees, and begins to wash their feet. After they eat, Jesus takes 3 disciples with Him to a garden to pray. Eventually the guards come to arrest Jesus and take him away.

FRIDAY

Jesus is brought to Pilate who tries to reason with the people to let Jesus go. The people do not budge and Pilate sends Jesus to be flogged. Jesus is then ordered to carry His cross up to a hill where He will be crucified.

SATURDAY
